Considered one of Canada's most beautiful cities, Stratford is currently best known for two reasons: It is home to North America's largest classic repertory theatre: the **Stratford Theatre Festival**, which brings thousands of guests each year to the area, and as the hometown of Canadian pop singer **Justin Beiber**.

Victorian-era buildings, charming shops and a unique mix of urban amenities tucked away throughout the town make this one of the most popular tourist destination towns for Canadians, especially those with an interest in the Dramatic/Theatrical Arts.

Stratford is a member of the Stratford Sister Cities program which was created to promote friendship and cultural exchange between participating countries. Participation is restricted to places called "Stratford" that have a Shakespeare Theatre or Festival.
